Sept minutes were approved.

Drinking Water: Val shared the document "Sequence of Drinking Water Steps" (see attached). Brent and Henry clarified what was involved in some of the steps. Brent shared the well water testing data for the 9 existing wells in our system. See the attached Anderson Valley Community Services District Water System Project Water Quality Data. He answered questions about how the system will treat the listed elements in raw well water.

Clean Water: Val shared the document "Sequence of Clean Water (Wastewater) Sequence"

Both Sequence documents list the order of steps that need to be accomplished to finish the projects. Both projects are well into the Rate Study step. Further steps such as LAFCo, CEQA, and Proposition 218 have already been extensively worked on.

Public Outreach: In the LAFCo process all the parcel owners in both boundaries will be contacted with an opportunity to protest the formation of the Drinking Water and Clean Water (Wastewater) districts. Once the LAFCo process is complete the parcel owners will again receive letters that will give them an opportunity to protest the rate structure. The CEQA process for both projects includes a public meeting which will give another opportunity to ask questions and express concerns.
