RESOLUTION DECLARING ANDERSON VALLEY  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DULY ORGANIZED.

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the  
County of Mendocino, California, that:

WHEREAS on March 10, 1970, an election was held  
pursuant to Section 56100 of the Government Code regarding  
the confirmation of the reorganization of County Service  
Area No. 1 as a community services district to be known as  
Anderson Valley Community Services District, and

WHEREAS the majority of the votes cast at said  
election is in favor of forming the Anderson Valley Com-  
munity Services District, and

WHEREAS Section 61127 of the Government Code  
provides for the Board of Supervisors to declare a community  
services district duly organized where such a majority of  
votes cast is in favor of formation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND  
ORDERED as follows:

1. There is hereby declared to be duly organized  
under the community services district law a district to be  
known as the Anderson Valley Community Services District.

2. The purposes for which said district is formed  
shall be those set forth in Section 61600 of the Government  
Code, specifically:

(a) To supply the inhabitants of the district  
with water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation,  
industrial use, fire protection, and recreation.

(b) The collection, treatment, or disposal of  
sewage, waste, and storm water of the district and its  
inhabitants.

(c) The collection or disposal of garbage or refuse matter.

(d) Protection against fire.

(e) Public recreation by means of parks, including but not limited to aquatic parks and recreational harbors, playgrounds, golf courses, swimming pools, or recreation buildings.

(f) Street lighting.

(g) The equipment and maintenance of a police department or other police protection to protect and safeguard life and property.

(3) The boundaries of said district are as set forth in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.



NOES: None


ABSENT: Supervisors Sawyers
